Hearing God

KEY VERSE:

Deu 30:19-20 (TLV) - “I call the heavens and the earth to witness about you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Therefore choose life so that you and your descendants may live, by loving Adonai your God, listening to His voice and clinging to Him. For He is your life and the length of your days

Note the bold / underline on the verse is mine. The TLV is one of the few versions that uses the term Listening to His voice.

What does it mean to listen?

Deu 6:4 (TLV) - “SHEMA, Yisrael, Adonai Eloheinu, Adonai Echad.” – “Hear O Israel, the Lord our God, The Lord is One.”

Deu 6:5 (TLV) – “Love Adonai your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.”

The same word SHEMA (or sama H8085) is used in Deu 30 and Deu 6. It means to hear, listen to, obey

Hearing Lost & Restored

Gen 3:8 & 10 (NKJV) - "And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord" "So I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

John 10:27 (TLV) – "My sheep hear My voice. I know them, and they follow Me."

4 Types of Prophetic Perceptions

Seer

A Seer is a believer who primarily perceives spiritual insight through visual revelation. Rather than first receiving words, they often receive pictures, visions, dreams, symbols, scenes, or mental images that communicate what God is revealing.

A seer does not merely see with physical eyes; they perceive spiritual truth through imagery that often requires interpretation and testing against Scripture.

Simple Definition

A Seer is someone who most naturally receives revelation from God through pictures, visions, dreams, and symbolic imagery.

How a Seer Might Describe Their Experience

- "I keep seeing a picture in my mind."
- "I had a dream that seems spiritually significant."
- "When I pray for someone, I see an image."
- "A particular symbol keeps coming to mind."
- "I can picture the situation as I'm praying."

Biblical Example: Zechariah

Key Strength : Seers often help people see what God is doing when others only see natural circumstances.

Hearer

A Hearer is a believer who primarily perceives spiritual insight through words. Rather than first receiving pictures or visions, they often receive Scriptures, phrases, impressions, thoughts, or an inner sense of what God is saying.

This is not usually an audible voice. Most often it is the Holy Spirit bringing words, Scripture, or impressions to the heart and mind.

Simple Definition

A Hearer is someone who most naturally receives revelation from God through words, phrases, Scriptures, and inner impressions.

How a Hearer Might Describe Their Experience

- "I felt the Lord say..."
- "That Scripture kept coming to mind."
- "A phrase wouldn't leave me."
- "I sensed God speaking this to my heart."

- "I kept hearing the same thing during prayer."

Biblical Example: Samuel

Key Strength : Hearers often help people hear what God is saying through timely Scriptures, encouragement, wisdom, and Spirit-led words.

Feeler

A Feeler is a believer who primarily perceives spiritual insight through emotions, burdens, compassion, atmospheres, and spiritual sensitivity. Rather than first receiving pictures or words, they often sense what God is highlighting by what they are feeling.

A feeler is not simply emotional. They are often sensitive to what is happening in the hearts of people and may carry burdens that lead them into prayer, encouragement, or action.

Simple Definition

A Feeler is someone who most naturally receives revelation from God through compassion, burdens, emotions, and spiritual sensitivity.

How a Feeler Might Describe Their Experience

- "I suddenly felt burdened to pray."
- "I sensed something was wrong."
- "My heart became heavy for that person."
- "I felt overwhelming compassion."
- "I walked into the room and sensed the atmosphere."

Biblical Example: Jeremiah; Nehemiah

Key Strength : Feelers often help people **feel the heart of God** through compassion, prayer, encouragement, comfort, and presence.

Knower

A Knower is a believer who primarily perceives spiritual insight through sudden understanding, discernment, or inner certainty. Rather than first receiving pictures, words, or emotions, they simply know something that the Holy Spirit is revealing.

This knowing is not based on natural reasoning alone. It often comes suddenly and carries a sense of conviction, clarity, or certainty.

Simple Definition

A Knower is someone who most naturally receives revelation from God through sudden insight, discernment, understanding, and inner knowing.

How a Knower Might Describe Their Experience

- "I don't know how I know, I just know."
- "I suddenly understood what was happening."
- "I knew I needed to call that person."
- "I sensed this was the right decision."
- "I had a strong conviction about it."

Biblical Example: Peter (with Ananias and Saphira)

Key Strength : Knowers often help people understand what God is doing by bringing wisdom, discernment, clarity, and direction.
